We're excited to partner with you to support the children and families in your care. Our Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) provides individualized support while working as part of your team and following your center's routines and classroom expectations.



### YOUR PARTICIPATION

is an important part of a successful partnership.



#### Welcome the RBT as Part of Your Team

Introduce the RBT to your staff and include them in daily routines, communication, and team activities.



#### Share Information

Help the RBT understand the child by sharing what works well, what may be challenging, and any classroom strategies that support their success.



#### Collaborate Daily

Communicate with the RBT about the child's day, goals, and any changes. Your observations help guide support.



#### Support Consistency

Allow the RBT to implement strategies and collect data as part of the behavior support plan.



#### Provide a Supportive Environment

Continue to follow your center's policies and routines. The RBT will do the same.



#### Partner with Families

Families are key team members. Help the RBT and family stay connected by sharing updates and celebrating progress.



### WE HANDLE THE LOGISTICS

Our office communicates with the daycare regarding scheduling changes and keeps in contact to ensure everything goes smoothly. We ask that you:

#### BCBA SUPERVISION

A Board Certified Behavior Analyst (BCBA) supervises the case either in person or via Telehealth. The BCBA is responsible for the treatment plan and ensures high-quality services.

**The BCBA will update the family and center on progress.**



#### PROFESSIONAL & RELIABLE SUPPORT

The RBT is trained, supervised, and supported by Move Up ABA to provide high-quality, ethical services in your daycare.



#### INDIVIDUALIZED, EVIDENCE-BASED SUPPORT

The RBT follows a behavior support plan designed for the child and approved by a BCBA. Strategies are child-centered and integrated into natural routines and activities.



#### OPEN & ONGOING COMMUNICATION

We maintain regular communication with your team and the child's family. You'll receive updates on progress and have a point of contact at our office for any questions or concerns.



#### DATA-DRIVEN PROGRESS

The RBT collects data to monitor progress toward goals and shares insights with the BCBA, family, and your team.

# ABA IN THE DAYCARE SETTING

In a daycare setting, the roles and responsibilities of the daycare staff and ABA RBT are distinct but complementary. Both play crucial roles in supporting a student's developmental needs.



## DAYCARE STAFF

- ✓ Provide the main directives and structure for the child's day-to-day activities
- ✓ Facilitates social interactions and play/activity options
- ✓ Assist the child with direct toileting tasks
- ✓ Provide any meals or snacks



## ABA STAFF

- ✓ Shadow the child and provide prompts to support learning, engagement, and social interactions
- ✓ Implement visual supports to enhance understanding and reduce challenging behavior
- ✓ Track any required toileting schedule, assist with handwashing, and eating.
